



**Aim:** To get the participants to discuss the data needed to assess the road safety situation in regards to pedestrians and plan a prevention programme

**Time:** 30 minutes including 20 minutes small group work and 10 minutes group discussion

**Method:** Small group exercise and facilitated discussion

**Materials:** Data needs for pedestrian safety

**Exercise:**

The facilitator divides the group into small groups of 4 and asks each group to review and discuss the following questions. Each group is to appoint a reporter, who will report back to the larger group.

Discuss the information you could collect when considering the safety requirements for pedestrians, under the following three headings. Consider situations in which that information would be most useful.
