Handout: Data needs for pedestrian safety



Aim: To get the participants to discuss the data needed to assess the road safety situation in regards to pedestrians and plan a prevention programme

Time: 30 minutes including 20 minutes small group work and 10 minutes group discussion

Method: Small group exercise and facilitated discussion

Materials: Data needs for pedestrian safety

Exercise:

The facilitator divides the group into small groups of 4 and asks each group to review and discuss the following questions. Each group is to appoint a reporter, who will report back to the larger group.
